

DESCRIPTION

Some customers may complain that the rubber protector comes off the side step molding. The protector hangs down causing a poor appearance concern.



This concern may occur when the vehicle is driven in freezing temperatures. Snow and moisture adhere and freeze onto the rubber protector and when the door is opened, the rubber protector can tear or stretch, coming off the fasteners.

The material of the rubber protector around the fasteners has been changed to increase the holding force to the fasteners.

Customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.



- 1. Verify customer concern.
- 2. Remove the twelve (12) fasteners (A) and rubber protector (B) using a fastener remover.



- 3. Install a new rubber protector.
- 4. Repeat the repair on the opposite side of vehicle as necessary.
- 5. Verify repair.
