Dealers must perform this Service Campaign on all affected vehicles prior to customer retail delivery and whenever an affected vehicle is in the shop for any maintenance or repair.

When a vehicle arrives at the Service Department, access Hyundai Motor America's "Warranty Vehicle Information" screen via WEBDCS to identify open Campaigns.

**Description:** This bulletin provides a service procedure to replace the rear door curtain ECU. Certain vehicles may exhibit a condition where the rear door curtains will not roll up or down.

#### Service Procedure:


1. Remove the rear driver side door frame inner cover (A).

### NOTICE


Carefully pull the top left and top right corner to remove the side door frame cover.



2. Remove the rear door inside handle cover (B), and then remove the screw.



3. Remove the rear door pull-handle cap (C), and then remove the screw.


4. Separate the rear door trim from the door by pulling the lower part of the trim.





## NOTICE

When separating the trim (D), pull the upper part and lower part simultaneously. Otherwise, the trim may be broken.




6. Separate the door inside handle cage (F) by pushing the hook (E).





7. Disconnect the power connector (G), and then remove the rear door trim.




8. Using a needle nose plier remove the connector (H) from the metal bracket.

Remove the rear door curtain ECU (I) by sliding it upward as shown in the directional arrow.



9. Disconnect the connector (J1) by pressing the hook.

Disconnect the connector (J2) by pressing the locking tab.

10. Install the new ECU (K) in reverse of removal.



- 11. Initiate the rear driver side door curtain ECU as follows:
  - 1) Lift the switch (L) to partially expand it.
  - 2) Press the switch (L) to completely fold it.
  - 3) Lift the switch (L) to fully expand it.



12. Repeat same procedure above for the rear passenger side door.
