TOUCH SCREEN ONLY NAVIGATION SYSTEM (NON-PREMIUM): TELEMATIC UNIT LOCATION



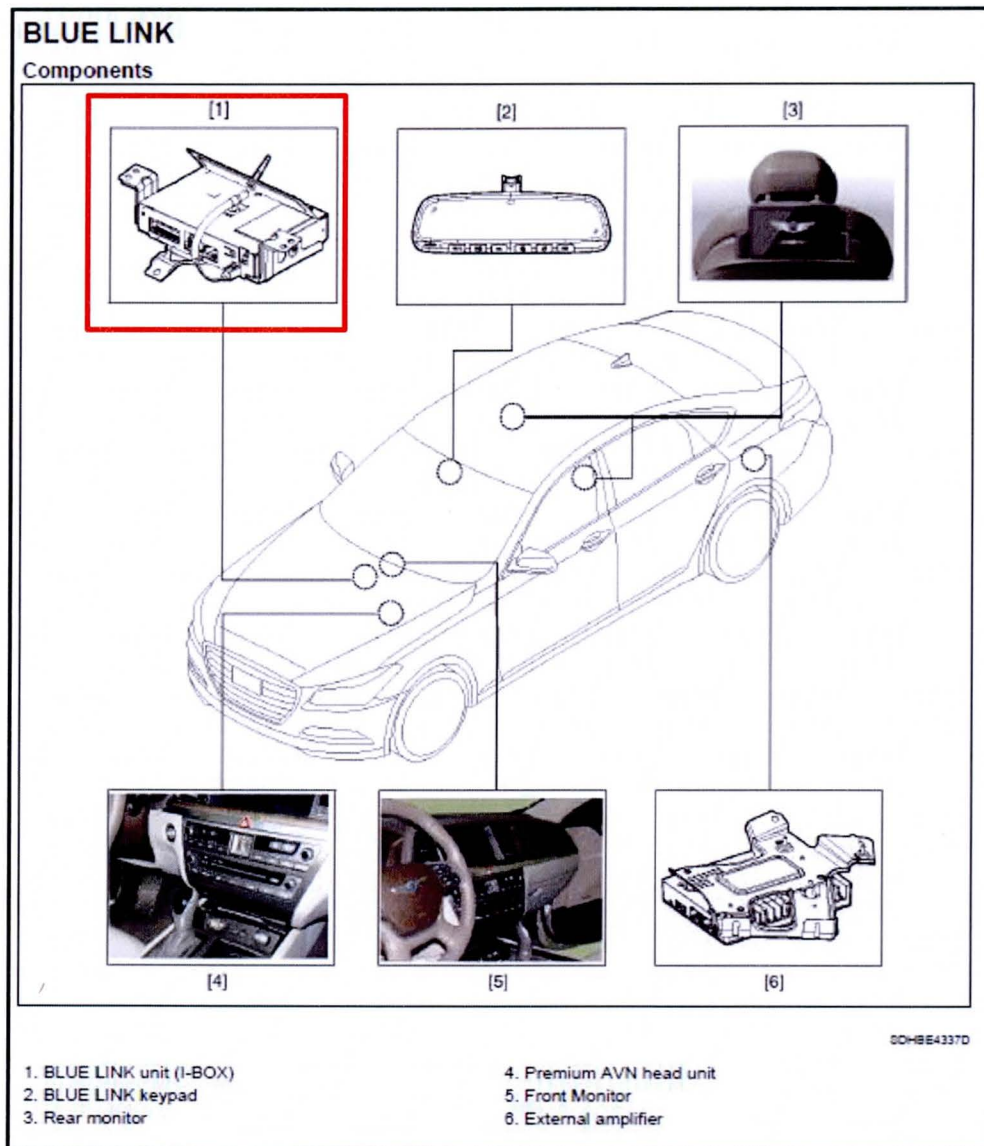
The TMU (Telematics Unit) is integrated inside the head unit. If TMU replacement is necessary, the entire head unit will need to be replaced.

CAUTION

- Never replace with a used head unit.
- Never swap the head units between vehicles. NOT even for testing purposes only.

PREMIUM 2.0 NAVIGATION SYSTEM: TELEMATIC UNIT LOCATION (JOG DIAL SYSTEM)



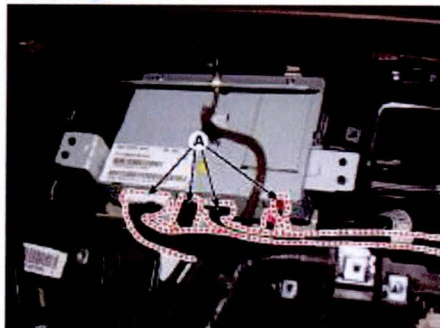
The TMU/I-Box (Telematics Unit) is external. Replacement of the TMU will require replacement of the Blue Link Unit (Item #1).

PROCEDURE: TELEMATIC UNIT REPLACEMENT

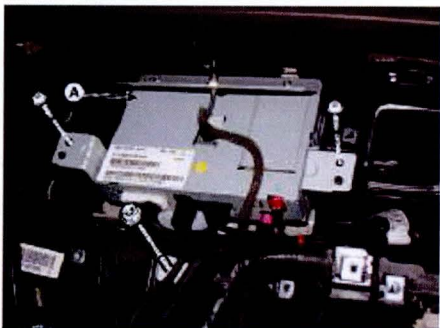
Jog Dial System, the TMU should be removed by the below procedure. Please refer to the shop manual for details.

Removal

1. Remove the battery (-) terminals.
2. Remove the AVN monitor (Body – "Premium AVN system")
3. Disconnect the cables and connectors (A) from the TMU unit.

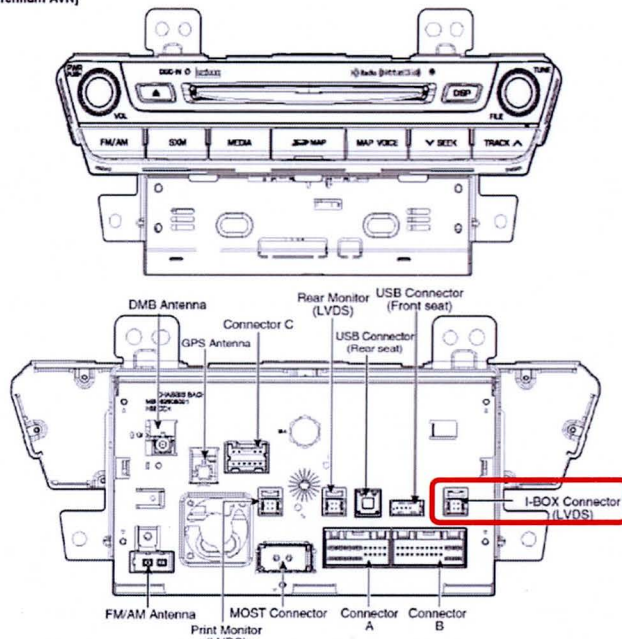


4. Remove the TMU unit after loosening the screws and nuts.
