Best practices when performing TSIB L-SB-0008-12


CONDITION

Customers experience a brake squeak noise from the front brakes when the brakes are cold and the vehicle is operated at slow speeds. TSIB L-SB-0008-12 was issued for this condition. This document provides reminders when performing L-SB-0008-12.

RECOMMENDATIONS

We recommend the following tasks when performing the repair.

- Do not polish and/or grind the brake disc.
 Also, do not replace the brake disc unless the disc thickness is less than 33.0 mm (1.30 in.).
- 2. Grease is included with the front disc brake pad kit. Apply a light coat of disc brake grease to the edges of the brake pads as shown in the illustration. And, ensure there is no oil and/or grease on the friction surfaces of the pads and the disc.

3. Make sure the single slotted pad is installed on the inside location of the brake disc.
