Description: This bulletin highlights the tire pressure specification differences between 18" and 19" tires for 2015MY Genesis (DH) vehicles.

Applicable Vehicles: All 2015+ MY Genesis (DH) vehicles.

2015MY Genesis (DH) vehicles come equipped with either 18" or 19" wheel/tire assemblies.
Tire pressure specifications depend on the tire size and driveline type (AWD or 2WD).

NOTICE

Front and rear tire pressures are NOT identical for 2WD vehicles equipped with 19" wheels.

Tire pressure specifications for all vehicles can be found on the placard located on the driver's door jamb. This specification should always be followed.

2015MY Genesis (DH) Tire Pressure Specification Table:

Tire Size	Front Tire Pressure Spec	Rear Tire Pressure Spec
18" (2WD and AWD)	33 psi	33 psi
19" (2WD vehicles)	33 psi	35 psi
19" (AWD vehicles)	35 psi	35 psi

NOTICE

All tire pressures should be checked when the tires are cold. "Cold tires" means the vehicle has not been driven for at least three hours or driven less than one mile.
