- There is no customer complaint about the gearbox.
- The gear lever display flashes.
- The following message is shown: "gearbox problem, journey can be continued with restrictions". This is a generic message in the instrument cluster that a transmission fault has occurred and Limp Home Mode *might* be activated if the malfunction continues.
- One of the following DTCs is stored in the gear shift control module, J587 (address word 81):
 - DTC P0605 (Internal control module ROM test error)
 - DTC P17EC (Unlock button electrical error)
