### **Service**

- 1. Verify that the customer complaint matches the condition described in the *Condition* section at the top of this TSB.
- 2. If the vehicle is within the New Vehicle Limited Warranty, complete the attached brake noise questionnaire.
- 3. Obtain a sound recording of the brake noise (a cell phone recording is acceptable as long as the noise can be clearly identified).
- 4. Email the questionnaire and sound recording to: **chassis@audi.com**. A sound recording is necessary to help determine the root cause of the noise and to help resolve the concern.
- 5. Contact a TAC consultant before proceeding with any repairs.
