## Condition/Concern

The low coolant light and/or DIC message may come on with the coolant level at the correct level.

## Recommendation/Instructions

Check the following for a possible level sensor connection concern:

- 1. Reservoir connector loose/unplugged
- 2. Reservoir connector wires broken at the connector, terminals uncrimped or wires pulled from the terminal at the connector
- 3. Reservoir connector wire terminals bent in the connector

If the sensor connection and terminals are okay follow any SI documents that pertain to this concern.
