- 1. Block off the hoses near the cooler connection with appropriate clamps.
- 2. Disconnect the cooler from the lines and remove the cooler.
- 3. Prefill the new cooler on the bench and cap off the pre-filled cooler ends for installation
- 4. Install the new pre-filled cooler on the vehicle and remove the clamps on the hoses.
- 5. Follow the Power Steering System Bleed Procedure in service information.
