Condition/Concern

Some customers may comment that steam is coming from the front grille at idle, or on seeing vapor coming from the radiator after car washes.

The cause of this condition may be the result of rain or car-wash runoff water reaching the condenser, radiator and fan module (CRFM) where it can be vaporized and, with the right weather, can become visible condensate.

Recommendation/Instructions

Important: This condition does not affect the performance or driveability of the vehicle, and is temporary; only lasting until all the moisture has vaporized.

Engineering is aware of the concern and is working on a resolution. Once a solution is available, this PI will be updated.
