Subject: Normal Characteristic - Daytime Running Lights Turn Off When The Turn Signals Are

Activated

Models: 2014 Chevrolet Camaro

The following diagnosis might be helpful if the vehicle exhibits the symptom(s) described in this PI.

Condition/Concern

Some customers may comment that the Daytime Running Lamp (DRL) will turn off when the turn signal is turned on. This will only happen if the vehicle is equipped with High Intensity Discharge (HID) headlamps.

Example: When the left turn signal is turned on, the left DRL will turn off. When the right turn signal is turned on, the right DRL will turn off.

Recommendation/Instructions

This is the normal operation of this lighting system, and no repairs should be made to try to repair this. This is a design characteristic due to the close proximity of the daytime running lights to the turn signal which may make it harder to see the illumination of the turn signal during bright daylight conditions.

Customer Information

Please communicate to the customer this condition is a normal operating characteristic of their vehicle. It will not impact the designed performance or reliability of the vehicle. Please share this information with the customer, including a copy of this message.
