This service update includes vehicles in dealer inventory and customer vehicles that return to the dealership for any reason. This bulletin will expire at the end of the involved vehicle's New Vehicle Limited Warranty period.

PURPOSE

This bulletin provides a service procedure to reprogram the Sensing and Diagnostic Module (SDM) on certain 2014 model year Chevrolet SS and Chevrolet PPV vehicles. After service replacement of SDMs which contain the Inertial Measurement Unit (IMU), the IMU sensor should be rezeroed. The SDM set up procedure which is run after replacement did not have the process to re-zero the IMU sensor for these vehicles. This omission does not impact airbag performance; however, some Electronic Brake Control Modules (EBCM) will not activate the Hill Hold Assist (HAS) feature until this process is performed.

This service procedure should be completed as soon as possible on involved vehicles currently in dealer inventory and customer vehicles that return to the dealer for any type of service during the New Vehicle Limited Warranty coverage period.

VEHICLES INVOLVED

All involved vehicles are identified by VIN in the Global Warranty Management System – Investigate Vehicle History Application. Dealership technicians should always check this site to confirm vehicle involvement prior to beginning any required inspections and/or repairs. It is important to routinely use this tool to verify eligibility because not all similar vehicles may be involved regardless of description or option content.

PART INFORMATION

No parts are required.

SERVICE PROCEDURE

1. Re-zero the internal measurement unit (IMU) sensor by performing a yaw sensor learn. Refer to *Vehicle Yaw Sensor Learn* in SI.
