



 Poor trim overlap of finisher on front right door (X) and correct trim overlap (tick). • Check condition of both the left and the right doors.




- 3. Remove affected door exterior mirror (see TOPIx Workshop Manual, Section 501-09).



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
11. Slide up, remove, and discard the door B-pillar trim.


15. Slide the new door B-pillar trim in place.






Rear Door


32. Remove the cap and fixing.



33. Displace the door margin seal.




34. Remove two (2) fixings.




