




3. NOTE: hold the HD Radio® tuner in place when removing the four Torx bolts.




4. Remove the HD Radio® tuner module.




5. Install the new HD Radio® tuner module.

7. Install the two electrical connectors.




8. Instal the rear right quarter trim panel (see TOPIx Workshop Manual, section 501-05).




- 1. Disconnect the battery ground cable (see TOPIx Workshop Manual, section 414-00).

- **3.** Remove the luggage compartment floor cover.




4. Remove the left side access panel.




5. Remove the left side floor access panel.




6. Remove the left side trim panel.

 - Torque: 10 Nm.




- **8.** Remove the left side lower tailgate opening trim panel.

 - Torque: 10 Nm.




- **9.** Fold down the rear left seat for access.

 - Torque: 10 Nm.




12. CAUTION: make sure that excessive force is not used. Failure to follow this instruction may result in damage to the vehicle.



Remove the module for access.


- Remove the two bolts.
