Content <u>Issue:</u>

Post a Service Interval Reset, on key through starts only, the Service Required message will appear on the Instrument Cluster for <1 second (when no service is required). No customer symptoms until a service reset has been performed. When an actual service is required the message will appear for 4 seconds as design intent.

Cause:

Distance to Next Service initialisation value management between ECM and Instrument Cluster (first 900ms).

Action:

At this time, a solution is not available. A solution to this incorrect transient message is being developed and is anticipated to be available in the 1st quarter of 2016.

Please reassure customers that this is a transient message which, although only temporarily displayed (less than 1 second), incorrectly indicates that service is required. Where service is actually required the Service Required indicator will be displayed on the instrument cluster for 4 seconds.

Where this is reported by customers with 2016MY vehicles, they can see the estimated distance to next service by selecting this through the instrument cluster menu functions.

Please reassure customers that this momentary illumination of the Service Required indicator is a recognised issue and the it does not indicate service is actually needed.
