Today, April 15, 2015, American Honda is announcing a warranty extension for some 2008-2011 Accord and 2010-2011 CR-V vehicles for continued high oil consumption after having service bulletin 11-049, *Product Update: Software Update to Improve Fuel Injector and VTC Timing* performed. To increase customer confidence, American Honda is extending the warranty coverage on the piston rings and pistons to 8 years from the original date of purchase or 125,000 miles, whichever comes first.

Service bulletins 12-087 and 12-089, *Warranty Extension: Sticking Rings Resulting in High Engine Oil Consumption* will be posted on Service Information today in support of this warranty extension, and it includes parts, repair, and warranty information related to the campaign.

American Honda expects to notify customers of this warranty extension in late Spring 2015.
