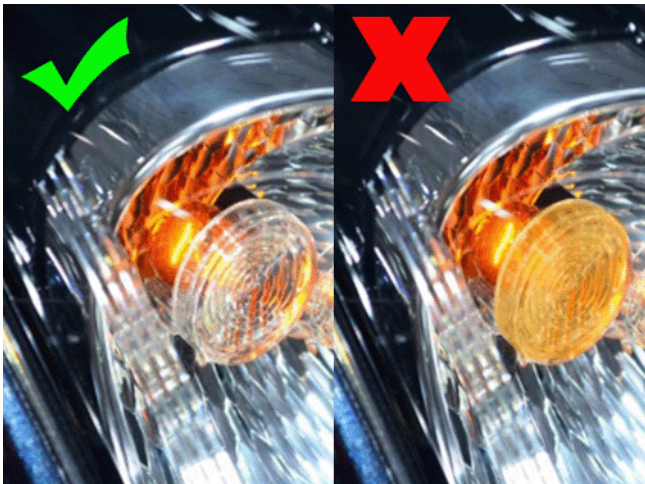
**Subject:** Headlamp Turn Signal Diffuser Lens Amber Colored Instead of Clear

**Models:** 2013 Chevrolet Cruze  
Built Prior to May 24, 2013

### Condition/Concern

Some customers may comment that the diffuser/lens for the turn signal inside the headlamp(s) assembly is an amber color instead of clear. This condition may be caused by some headlamps being assembled with mixed material that produced an amber color instead of clear.

### Recommendation/Instructions



If this condition exists, replace the headlamp(s) that have the amber colored diffuser/lens. Refer to Headlamp Replacement in SI.

**Note:** Both headlamps should have clear diffuser/lens for the turn signal inside the headlamp assembly. Only the bulb should be amber in color.
