Subject: Information on Fuel Tank Replacement

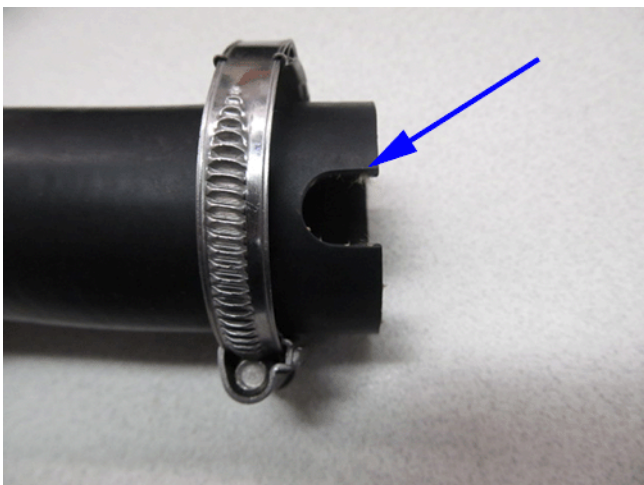
Models: 2006-2008 Saturn Ion

The service replacement fuel tank (P/N 20870462) for the Saturn Ion is from a Chevrolet Cobalt.



1. Saturn Ion Fuel Fill Hose
2. Chevrolet Cobalt Fuel Fill Hose

When a dealership replaces a fuel tank on a Saturn Ion, they **MUST** also replace the fuel filler hose with one from a Chevrolet Cobalt.



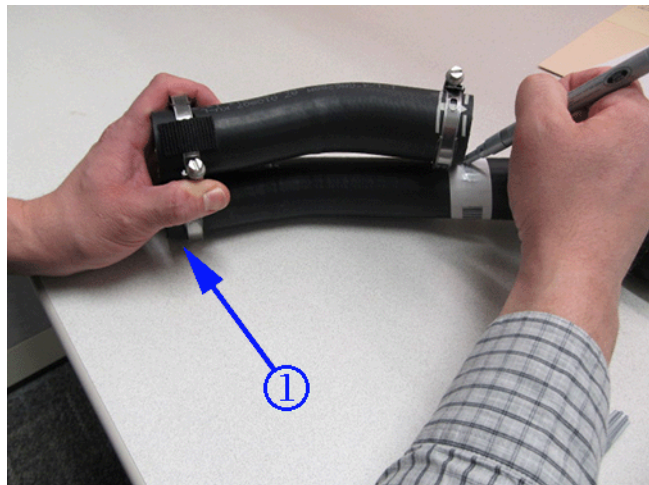
This is because there is an interface issue with current Saturn Ion fill hose alignment feature position notch. The alignment feature position is 180 degrees different for new service tank replacement.

During Replacement of the Fuel Tank

When replacing the fuel tank, replace the fuel fill hose.

The fuel fill hose (P/N 20757866) will be too long and must be trimmed by following the procedure below.

1. Remove old fuel fill hose.
2. Align both hoses side by side.



1. Both notch ends of hoses on same side.
3. Using a paint pen or equivalent, mark where the original hose ends so that both hoses are the same length starting with the notched ends of the hoses.
4. Cut the hose opposite of the side with the notch in one end.
Important: When cutting the hose, be sure the cut is as straight as possible. Failure to cut the hose straight could result in leaks.
5. Transfer the clamp on the newly cut hose.
