## Subject: Driver Outside Wide Load Mirror Turn Signal Too Bright

Models: 2015 Chevrolet Silverado 1500
2015 Chevrolet Silverado 2500/3500 with RPO AVF
2015 GMC Sierra 1500
2015 GMC Sierra 2500/3500 with RPO AVF
With Mirror RPO DPN or DQS

Attention: This Bulletin also applies to any of the above models that may be Export vehicles.

## Condition

Some customers may comment that the driver's outside wide load mirror turn signal is too bright. This concern is more noticeable when driving at night.

## Cause

The cause of this condition may be the brightness of LED's in the turn signal on the mirror.

## Correction

Replace the original upper left hand outside rearview mirror glass only with a new part designed to reduce the intensity of the LED indicator.


1. Remove the upper outside rearview mirror glass (1). Refer to the appropriate Outside Rearview Mirror Glass Replacement - Upper procedure in SI.
2. Install the new upper outside rearview mirror glass. Refer to the appropriate Outside Rearview Mirror Glass Replacement- Upper procedure in SI.
