## PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

Subject: Diagnostic Tip for Malfunction Indicator Lamp (MIL) On, DTC P0503 Only Set with No Other Symptoms

Models: 2015 Chevrolet Corvette

**Equipped with Manual Transmission (MEK or MEL)** 

Attention: This PI also applies to any of the above models that may be Export vehicles.

## Condition/Concern

Some customers may comment on a Malfunction Indicator Lamp (MIL) on. During diagnosis you may notice that the Engine Control Module (ECM) has stored a P0503 DTC. No other symptoms will be present.

This may be caused the vehicle software interpreting a vehicle speed sensor signal change following a wheel spin event as a vehicle speed sensor fault.

## Recommendation/Instructions

Important: Do NOT replace the vehicle speed sensor for this issue.

Engineering is aware of this condition and working on a resolution. Once a solution becomes available, this PI will be updated. In the meantime, the technician can clear the code.

## **Customer Information**

Please communicate to the customer that we apologize for this inconvenience and that General Motors is working on a solution for this concern. Once a solution is available, this PI will be updated with additional details - allowing dealership personnel to contact the customer to schedule a service appointment and repair the vehicle.
