This PI has been revised to update the Model Years, Recommendation/Instructions, remove Parts Information and Warranty Information. Please discard PI1322.

Condition/Concern

Some customers may comment on a notchy or stick/slip feeling in the steering wheel, near the center position, after a duration of time on the highway while making lane changes.

This may be due to increased effort required to overcome residual friction inside the steering gear after driving long periods with no steering input.

Recommendation/Instructions

Refer to Special Coverage #14232.
