

# PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

Subject: Vehicle Rides Rough and/or Fluid Leak from Rear of Vehicle Near Tire

Models: 2015 Chevrolet SS

## Condition/Concern



Some customers may comment that the vehicle rides rough in the rear and/or that the vehicle is leaking from the rear shock absorber location.

This may be caused by a defective seal within the rear shock absorber, leaving particles which will not allow the absorber to work as intended.

## **Recommendation/Instructions**

If you encounter a vehicle with the above concern, visually inspect for a leaking rear absorber.

Replace the affected shock absorber. Refer to Shock Absorber Replacement in SI.
