## PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

Subject: Speedometer Goes Blank or Trip Odometer Does Not Increase

Models: 2015 Chevrolet Sonic, Trax Built Prior to the VIN Breakpoints Below

#### Attention: This PI also applies to any of the above models that may be South America Export vehicles.

Chevrolet Sonic	'1' VIN digit 1	March 6, 2015

#### **Condition/Concern**

Some customers may comment that the speedometer goes blank or trip odometer does not increase.

This condition may be caused by a software anomaly.

#### **Recommendation/Instructions**

An updated software calibration has been released to address this condition. Reprogram the instrument cluster with the latest calibration available on TIS2WEB

**Important:** For the "trip odometer does not increase" issue, after reprogramming the cluster, reset the trip odometer by pressing and holding down the trip reset button.

### Warranty Information

For vehicles repaired under the Bumper-to-Bumper coverage (Canada Base Warranty coverage), use the following labor operation. Reference the Applicable Warranties section of Investigate Vehicle History (IVH) for coverage information.
