PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

Subject: Diagnostic Tip: Performance Data Recorder SD Card Not Recognized

Models: 2015 Chevrolet Corvette

With RPO UQT

Condition/Concern

Customer may comment that the vehicle does not recognize the SD card when inserted into the hub in the glove box. There may or may not be an error message displayed on the radio display.

Recommendation/Instructions

The SD card needs to be formatted to FAT32 and also have a class 10 designation in order to be compatible with the system.

If the vehicle is intermittently losing connection with the SD card, there may be an issue with the connector at the back of the SD card hub, or the harness being stressed causing a poor connection at the hub.

Note: Although the system is capable of reading larger SD cards, the system performance is optimized if a 32gb or less SD card is used.
