

Condition/Concern

The Warranty Parts Center has received overhead entertainment displays back with the LVDS connector broken off of the display as shown below.



Recommendation/Instructions

To prevent damage, do not let the weight of the display hang from the LVDS cable when removing an overhead video display. Instead, support the display and disconnect the LVDS cable to avoid damage to connector or circuit board.
