## PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

**Subject:** Active Rev Matching Inoperative

**Models:** 2015 Chevrolet Corvette  
with manual transmission RPO MEL

The following diagnosis might be helpful if the vehicle exhibits the symptom(s) described in this PI.

### Condition/Concern

Some customers may comment that the Active Rev Matching feature is inoperative and upon further inspection technician may find a P0731 stored in the engine control module.

### Recommendation/Instructions

If you should encounter this condition on a 2015 equipped with a MEL RPO transmission update the calibration in the ECM as there was software released to correct this condition.

### Warranty Information

For vehicles repaired under warranty use:
