#### Subject: (BEV) DTC P0ABB P0A0C S15 Manual Service Disconnect Broken Or Cannot Be Removed

# Models: 2014 - 2015 Chevrolet Spark EV With RPO EN0

The following diagnosis might be helpful if the vehicle exhibits the symptom(s) described in this PI.

## **Condition/Concern**

A technician may comment there is a P0ABB or P0A0C set. While attempting to disable the high voltage system, he may find that the S15 Manual Service Disconnect (MSD) is not fully latched or cannot be removed.

### **Recommendation/Instructions**

DTC P0A0C or P0ABB could be induced if the MSD was not fully seated and latched. P0ABB could be induced if the MSD was pulled without allowing the vehic CAN Buss to power down or if the 12V Accessory Battery was not disconnected.

**Important:** If the MSD is difficult to remove or cannot be removed, STOP! Please follow this diagnostic or repair process thoroughly and complete each step. If the condition exhibited is resolved without completing every step, the remaining steps do not need to be performed.
