Subject: Top Front Strut Mount Appearance Concern

Models: 2016 Chevrolet Camaro

Condition/Concern

Some customers may comment on the appearance of the front struts inside the shock towers. They may see what appears to be a rust-like material around the rim of the upper strut mount. This can be seen in the picture below.



This concern is not actually rust, rather, is caused by an applied layer of rubber to the top of the strut that does not completely cover the nylon underneath. This appearance will not affect performance or durability of the vehicle. It is strictly a cosmetic concern..

Recommendation/Instructions

Important: IMPORTANT: Do NOT replace any parts for this condition. Engineering is aware of the condition and working on a resolution. This PI will be updated once a repair becomes available. New parts are expected to be ready in the late 1st / early 2nd quarter of 2016 to resolve this concern.
