## AFFECTED VEHICLES: 2012 i-MiEV

## **PURPOSE**

For the 2012 i-MiEV, the vehicle's Main Drive Lithium-ion Battery is covered for defects in material and workmanship for 8 years or 100,000 miles, whichever comes first. In the event the Main Drive Lithium-ion Battery cannot be charged to full available capacity when properly connected to a properly functioning compatible charger, however, Mitsubishi is extending the warranty on the Main Drive Lithium-ion Battery to 10 years or 100,000 miles, whichever comes first.

This warranty extension does not apply to gradual capacity loss based on time and usage. The capacity of the Main Drive Lithium-ion Battery, like other commonly used Li-ion batteries, will decrease according to time and usage. This type of decrease in battery capacity is normal.

The TSB outlining the warranty extension qualifications and testing procedures will be available later today on MEDIC and MDL.
