46 Steering angle sender voltage too small

Condition

- Customer may report that Electronic Stability Control (ESC) and Tire Pressure Monitoring System (TPMS) warnings are intermittently displayed in the instrument cluster.
- The following DTCs are stored in the ABS control module, J104 (address word 03):
 - DTC B116816 (Steering angle sensor voltage too low, passive/sporadic)
 - DTC C114602 (Tire pressure monitoring display signal error, passive sporadic)

Technical Background

During vehicle start-up, there may be a drop in voltage that causes the DTCs to be stored in the ABS control module, J104 (address word 03). However, the power steering control module, J500 (address word 44), must be updated to correct this condition.

Production Solution

Improved power steering control unit software.

Service

- 1. Check the software version of the power steering control module, J500 (address word 44):
 - If the software version is already at the new software version listed in the table below, then this bulletin does not apply. Continue with diagnosis outside of this bulletin.
 - If the software version is lower than the new software version listed in the table below, update the software.
- 2. After updating the software, calibrate the steering angle sensor.

SVM Update Instructions

- 1. Follow all instructions in TSB 2011732: 00 Software Version Management (SVM), operating instructions.
- 2. Update the power steering control module, J500 (address word 44) using the SVM action code as listed in the table below, if necessary.
