96 Parking aid continuous tone comes on too early

Condition

When the driver is parking the vehicle, the continuous parking aid warning tone begins too soon. The continuous warning tone begins when the vehicle is approximately two feet away from an object, although it should not begin until the vehicle is one foot away from an object.

Technical Background

Incorrect software parameters in the vehicle electrical system control module, J519 (address word 09), cause the condition. Only A6 S line and S6 vehicles with front and rear parking aid (PR 7X2) are affected.

Production Solution

New parameterization/coding of the vehicle electrical system control module.

Service

- 1. Confirm that the continuous parking aid warning tone begins too soon by first enabling the parking aid (or by driving in reverse so that the parking aid turns on automatically), then slowly driving the vehicle toward an object. Be sure to check with the vehicle moving both forward and in reverse.
- 2. Once the parking aid warning tone is continuous, park the vehicle and measure the distance to the object (Figure 1):
 - If the distance is approximately <u>one foot</u>, the system is working correctly and no repair is needed.
 - If the distance is approximately two feet, perform the SVM update below.





Figure 1. Vehicle parked at a distance of one foot (top) and at a distance of two feet (bottom).

SVM Update Instructions

- 1. Follow all instructions in the TSB 2011732: 00 Software Version Management (SVM), operating instructions.
- 2. Update the vehicle electrical system control module, J519 (address word 09) using the SVM action code as listed in the table below if necessary.
