- 2. Update the radio, R (address word 56), using the SVM action code as listed in the table below.

- 3. Turn the vehicle off and allow it to sleep.
 - Lock the doors for at least two minutes.
 - Monitor the red LED on the door. Once it transitions from a fast blink to a slow blink, the vehicle has entered sleep mode.

- 5. Verify that the radio station or track information is showing in the DIS.
