

2007-2015 Eos – Acceptable Conditions Concerning Water Leaks

February 13, 2015: Update to Model Year.

It is acceptable to have a few water droplets enter the vehicle under certain circumstances. As described in the Owner's Manual, this vehicle is not to be subjected to high pressure washes, neither brushless automatic nor handheld. Under these situations the seals cannot withstand the amount of pressure generated (up to 3500 PSI). Also it may be likely in a heavy rain for there to be an occasional seepage. This should not be severe, but is possible due to the external sealing of the hardtop.

**Sealing evaluation**



- Presence of small water drops during sealing test → Sealing OK
- Single water drops that stay in the glass (not run) → Sealing OK

Good sealing means also that no water drops reaches dashboard, door panel or side trims.  
*Always perform test on still-standing vehicle*

- Water run → Sealing NOK
- Continuous presence of water drops → Sealing NOK
- Water splash → Sealing NOK
