#### Correction

Perform normal parasitic drain diagnostics. Refer to Diagnostic Procedure Instructions in SI.

## **Service Procedure:**

Perform battery drain test. Refer to Battery Electrical Drain/Parasitic Load Test in SI.

If no issues are identified and battery draw is 3 amps or higher, contact GM Technical Assistance (TAC) for further instructions.
