In the **Service** sub-menu, select the **Reset** menu item.

Confirm request with OK.

#### Vehicles with Basic text message display:

Switch off the ignition.

Push 0.0 / SET and hold down.

Switch on the ignition.



2012-2014 Beetle, CC, Eos, GTI, Jetta GLI, and Tiguan Equipped with CCTA or CBFA Engines – Oil Leak From Oil Drain Plug Area After Oil Change and/or Drain Plug Replacement

July 26, 2013: Update to Information.

An oil leak from around the oil drain plug noted after oil change, and/or drain plug replacement, may be caused by installation of incorrect drain plug. Correct part number drain plug is based on the oil pan design as shown below. Original drain plug is 18mm hex for both style oil pans.



If the oil pan has a boss use part number: N 908 132 02 Drain plug w/seal





If the oil pan is flat, use drain plug and washer: N 911 679 01 Plug N 013 81 57 Seal
