SUBJECT: **Release of DiagnosticLink® 8.02**

SUBJECT DETAIL

On Wednesday, April 29th, 2015, DiagnosticLink® 8.02 will be made available. Current subscribers of DiagnosticLink® 8.0 or 8.01 may upgrade to DiagnosticLink® 8.02 at no cost. All DTNA Service shops are required to maintain the latest version of software on each of their stations by purchasing a subscription.

All users with DiagnosticLink® 8.0 - 8.01 installed, must upgrade their version by accessing the ordering site at <http://diagnosticlink.nexiq.com>, and downloading the latest software via the My Accounts > My Orders link.

Important Note: Any authorized DTNA service facility servicing GHG14 units must at least have DiagnosticLink 8.01 or higher installed!

The following features are included in this release:

- Support for Western Star 5700XE.
- New Western Star 5700XE Cruise Control and ECC switch state panels.
- An optional field has been added to the software registration dialog which will allow users to specify a computer description (e.g. Service Bay3 Dell Computer). This will be visible in the Help About menu and the account section of the order site.
- User Name auto save feature is now optional.
- CPC backdoor password menu has been updated with instructions to contact local dealer or distributor as per announcement letter 15 CSA-3.
- Troubleshooting guides are now downloaded directly from PSL website for the most up-to-date service literature.
- Nexiq USB-Link drivers have been removed from installation package. If a device driver is not already installed and configured, a warning will display that no RP1210 devices are installed.
- Identification view, All Instruments, Chart, and User panels now allow users to collapse or expand individual ECUs (e.g. CPC, ACM, and MCM).
- The number of days remaining before a server connection is required is now displayed on the password dialog.

- Detroit Assurance panel is included to help troubleshoot VRDU01T and RDF01T under the Instrumentation panel section.

UPDATE INSTRUCTIONS

NOTE: It's recommended to first uninstall previous installations of DiagnosticLink (e.g. version 8.01) prior to installing current version.

1. Login to <https://diagnosticlink.nexiq.com>.
2. Go to My Account, My Organization, and select Subscriptions.
3. Click on the eyeglass icon under subscription area.
4. Click on the download DiagnosticLink 8.02 button.
5. Save the install package file to desktop.
6. Double click install package file (zip file).
7. Double click Setup.exe to run the DiagnosticLink 8.02 installer and follow the setup guide.
