PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

Subject: Starter or Flywheel Knock Noise on Start Up / Starter and Fuse Block Service Precautions

Models: 2012-2014 Chevrolet Cruze

Equipped with 1.8L Engine and Manual Transmission

Built Prior to January 10, 2014

This PI has been revised to end the part restriction on the starter. Please discard PI1175B.

Condition/Concern

Some customers may comment on a knock noise coming from the front of the vehicle on start up.

This may be caused by the starter not having a high enough cranking speed.

Recommendation/Instructions

Technicians should replace the starter and the fuse block. Refer to Starter Replacement (1.8L LUW and LWE) and Fuse Block Replacement in SI.

Note: The fuse block and starter must be matched in service. If either part is being serviced, assure proper matched usage.

- 55572439 (Starter) and 95937484 (Fuse Block) and 95937484 (Fuse Block) must be matched
- 55576980 (Starter) and 95476466, 96982033 or 95942232 (Fuse Block) must be matched
