This PI has been revised to update the Condition/Concern. Please discard Pl1383.

Condition/Concern

Some customers may comment on a DIC message of "Service Front Camera" or "Tire Learning Active" at start up.

This message may go away after one or more key cycles.

The forward collision alert and the tire pressure monitoring systems continue to function as design intended.

Recommendation/Instructions

An updated software calibration has been released to address this condition.

Update the cluster using the Service Programming System (SPS) procedure in SI with the latest calibrations available on TIS2WEB.
