

Condition/Concern


Some customers or technicians during Pre-Delivery Inspection (PDI) may notice a strip of black anti-abrasion tape attached to the underside of the rear liftgate or rear compartment lid.

Recommendation/Instructions

Important: DO NOT REMOVE THE ANTI-ABRASION TAPE.

The black tape attached to the underside of the liftgate/rear compartment lid is an anti-abrasion tape used to improve the power release function. If the tape is removed, the liftgate/rear compartment lid may not release high enough from the rear weatherstrip, causing difficulty opening.
