PRELIMINARY INFORMATION

Subject: Radio Display Touchscreen Inoperative


Models: 2014-2015 Buick Regal

Condition/Concern

A customer may comment that the radio touchscreen is inoperative. This may be caused by the radio display bezel contacting the touchscreen at the top center of the display.

Recommendation/Instructions

If this concern is encountered, remove the radio display bezel and Integrated Center Stack (ICS) from the dash, remove the bezel from the ICS, and re-connect the ICS in dash without the bezel. If the concern is still present, follow SI diagnostics for radio display malfunction and repair as necessary. If the concern is no longer present, inspect the inside top center of the bezel for a plastic tab that may be pressing on the display.



If the tab is found to be pressing on the display, carefully remove the tab using a sharp knife or equivalent by shaving the tab so that it is flush to outside edge or the bezel. Reassemble the display and bezel, and re-evaluate touchscreen operation.
