SUBJECT Reverse Light is Intermittently Inoperative

MODEL F30 (3 Series Sedan)

F31 (3 Series Sports Wagon)

F80 (M3 Sedan)

SITUATION

CCM (Check control message) is displayed indicating a "reverse light" is out.

CAUSE

There is a weak spring in bulb socket or bulb carrier (on the luggage compartment lid) which is causing a bad contact with the bulb.

PROCEDURE

If the vehicle has the intermittent situation described above, only replacing the light bulb will fix the vehicle for a short time; the vehicle comes back to the shop for the same issue.

Check the contact area at the bulb socket or carrier. Check the bracket tension. Replace the bulb socket if there is no or there is a poor "contact" with the bulb. Also replace the bulb if it has an open circuit.

Use clean gloves when touching the light bulb. Don't use tools with sharp edges. Don't apply excessive pressure.
