## SITUATION

The alarm system sporadically activates by itself or the vehicle horn will be activated after the siren comes on.

### CAUSE

Application error in DWA (Alarm System).

### PROCEDURE

In the event of a customer complaint, run diagnostics with ISTA and work through the corresponding Test module. Check the alarm counter and make sure no accessory is connected to the vehicle causing a false alarm.

If the vehicle I-level is lower than F020-15-07-502, connect to ISTA/P 3.56.1 or higher and perform a vehicle software update.

Note that ISTA/P will automatically reprogram and code all programmable control modules that do not have the latest software. For information on programming and coding with ISTA/P, refer to CenterNet / TIS / Technical Documentation / Programming and Diagnostics / ISTA/P Documentation.

Always connect a BMW approved battery charger / power supply (SI B04 23 10).

61 00 730	Refer to KSD2	Programming / encoding control unit(s)

If you are using a Main labor code for another repair, use the Plus code labor operation 00 00 556 instead.

Refer to KSD2 for the corresponding flat rate unit (FRU) allowances.

Work time labor operation code 61 00 006 is not considered a Main labor operation; however, it does require an individual punch time and an explanation on the repair order and in the claim comments.

### Vehicle Programming and Coding

If a control module was working properly and it fails to program correctly or requires initialization, please claim this additional work with the applicable KSD2 labor operations under the defect code listed above.

The diagnosis and repair of vehicles "arriving" with failed control modules or stored faults which will cause them to fail during programming cannot be claimed under the defect code listed in this bulletin.

# **Other Repairs**

If other eligible and covered work is performed "prior" to programming and coding the vehicle, claim this work with the applicable defect code and labor operations listed in KSD2.

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
