

# **SITUATION**

Programming with ISTA/P 3.57.4, or a more recent update, displays a new Pop-Up window providing options for systems programming.



## **INFORMATION**

In order to gain flexibility and save time when programming E-Series vehicles, ISTA/P now provides three options (as shown in the screenshot above) for programming the control units on the vehicle.


