DATE: Shortbed Crew Cab vehicles **only**

IF YOU CONFIRM

The fuel tank is slow or difficult to fill.

ACTION

Replace the vent tube that connects the charcoal canister to the fuel tank with the one from the Parts Information table.

NOTE: When working on or near the fuel system and its related components, please observe the General Precautions in the Electronic Service Manual (ESM) section, **FL – Fuel System**.

IMPORTANT: The purpose of "ACTION" (above) is to give you a quick idea of the work you will be performing. You MUST closely follow the entire Service Procedure as it contains information that is essential to successfully completing the repair.

SERVICE PROCEDURE

Replace the charcoal canister to fuel tank vent hose with the one from the Parts Information table.

Retainer


Hard tube

1. Disconnect vent hose at canister.

NOTE: See Figure A and Figure B for detail of "Quick connector" retainer release.



- 2. Disconnect vent hose from fuel tank.
- 3. Install new vent hose.

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
