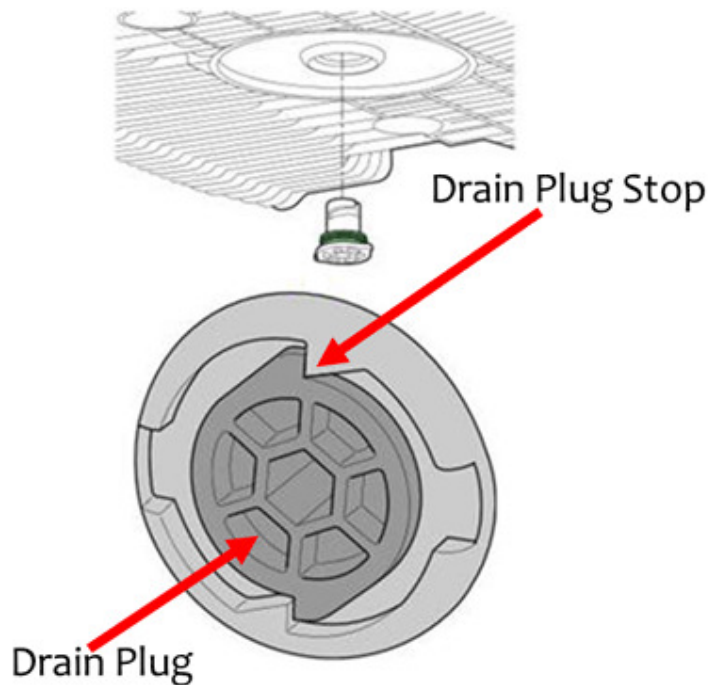

## **Procedure**

### Oil Pan Drain Plug

- Use the correct tool (8 mm allen (hex head) wrench) to remove or install the drain plug.
- If the maximum torque is reached, the hexagonal tool will slip through the plug.
- After draining the oil, always replace the drain plug assembly (o-ring included) with a new one.
- Torque the drain plug to its stop, do not over torque.
