Content	lssue:

The banjo joint on the brake calliper to brake hose may have a minor weep or show signs of dampness. This affects VIN range SAJAB4AN0GA900466 to SAJAB4AG5GA905809.

## Cause:

There has been some instances where the joint has shown signs of torque relaxation resulting in minor seal leakage.

## Action:

- -Confirm area shows signs of leakage.
- -Confirm two copper washers are fitted (one either side of the hose as per image 1) if non copper washers are fitted (as per image 2) or no washers are fitted then a replacement hose is required.
- -If copper washers are fitted then using a suitable torque wrench tighten the joints to 47Nm.
- -Once tightened pump the brake pedal 5 times holding it fully depressed for 10 seconds on the final pump.
- -Confirm no leakage is present release car to customer.
- -If leakage is present replace hose and submit ePQR.

NOTE - 47Nm is only applicable to vehicles fitted / being fitted with hoses that have copper washers.
