Customers have reported that chrome and black door finishers on the rear door become slightly adrift due to partial delamination at the base of the rear door 'B' post. (Please view attachment example)

Cause:-

Excess applied torque during profiling can cause the fixing screw to protrude through the moulding into the adhesive strip. Over time, this can weaken the adhesive creating the partial delamination.

Action:-

If vehicle is showing signs of delaminated finisher/waist seal between VIN's R00547 - U75475:

- 1. Replace rear door bright work finisher
- 2. Remove and discard the existing fixing screw and replace with C2Z31690
- 3. Torque fixing to 2.1Nm
