

2014-16 Mazda3 (Mexico built) vehicles with VINs starting with 3MZ

REAR MUDGUARD IS WARPED CAUSING POOR APPEARANCE/NOISE

DESCRIPTION

Some vehicles may exhibit a warped rear mudguard with the surface edge (A) visible from outside the vehicle, causing a poor appearance. In the worst case, it could touch the tire and cause a rubbing noise. The deformation is due to product variation.



Customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

- 1. Verify customer concern.
- Replace mud guards (both sides) with ones used for Japan production Mazda3 (JM1) according to the instructions on MS3 online or the Workshop Manual (section 09-16 MUDGUARD REMOVAL/INSTALLA-TION).
- 3. Verify repair.
