WHINING NOISE FROM SPEAKERS WHEN LISTENING TO AM RADIO WITH BLOWER MOTOR ON

DESCRIPTION

Some customers may complain about a whine noise from the speakers when listening to the AM radio with the blower motor on. This concern may be caused by an internal failure of the audio unit. To correct the problem, the internal circuit of the audio unit has been changed.

Customers having this concern should have their vehicle repaired using the following repair procedure.

REPAIR PROCEDURE

- 1. Verify customer concern.
- 2. Remove the audio unit and replace with a modified one according to the instructions on MS3 online or the Workshop Manual (section 09-20 AUDIO UNIT REMOVAL/INSTALLATION).
- 3. Verify repair.
