When removing the transportation steering wheel cover, residue from the cover may be found left on the steering wheel.

Cause

Degradation of the protective cover in certain climatic conditions.

Action

- 1. Obtain a 100% natural rubber glue eraser (see fig1) these can be obtained from craft / art shops or ordered on line from internet retailers.
- 2. Using the eraser carefully remove any white marks from the steering wheel (see fig 2).
- 3. Using a non-solvent based interior cleaner on a clean cloth rub off any residue that is left.
- 4. Polish the surface with a clean dry cloth.
